Pocket money

We recommend £60 per week to cover incidental expenses (postcards and stamps, souvenirs, soft drinks, ice creams etc.) **Please bring Sterling cash in £5 or £10 notes.** On arrival a £30 damage/loss deposit will be lodged with the Course Administrator and returned in full at the end of the course providing no keys have been lost and no damage or nuisance has been caused. *If extra pocket money has to be transferred during the course a handling fee of £25 will be charged.*

Money, passports, and tickets

These are handed in on arrival at the course office for safekeeping by the Course Administrator. Students may withdraw small amounts of money from our 'bank' as needed.

Contact Lenses

If you wear contact lenses please ensure that you bring the correct cleaning equipment and a spare pair of glasses.

Laundry

Personal laundry will be done for you once or twice a week; bed linen is provided and will be laundered once a week. Bath / swimming towels are **not** provided.

What to bring - Please ensure that **all** clothes and belongings are clearly labelled.

General

- Everyday clothes, which are casual and machine-washable. Summer temperatures vary between 15°C and 30°C, so bring some warm clothes as well as summer clothes
- A waterproof jacket and an umbrella
- Some old clothes for art and craft activities and water-sports
- A set of smarter clothes (for evening parties)
- A swimming towel
- A bath towel
- A lockable suitcase
- A padlock for your locker
- Adapter (3 pin) for electrical appliances. The current in the UK is 220 volts
- Something typical from your own country (e.g. music, flag, hat) for the international evenings optional

Sports clothes / equipment

- Discovery Summer provides basic sports equipment. If you are a good player you may like to bring your own equipment (e.g. tennis racquet)
- Sports clothes / track suit
- Swim suit
- A swimming cap for those with long hair (Uppingham only)
- Trainers for indoor and outdoor sports

Special Sports Options

- **Horse riding:** A hard hat and boots will be provided. Bring loose trousers (not jeans) and a long sleeved top.
- **Golf:** Bring your own clubs if you can. Half sets can be provided if we are advised in advance.
- **Tennis:** Bring a racquet and tracksuit / shorts and sports shoes. Balls will be provided.
- **Dance:** Leotard, jazz pants, crop tops and leggings - (preferably bright coloured tops and one pair of black leggings). Any dance shoes you own (eg ballet, tap), one warm top to wear after class.
- **Water-sports:** Swimwear, spare towel, clothes that can get wet (T-shirt, shorts, tracksuit but NOT jeans), 2 pairs of old trainers that can get wet.

Shrewsbury Sports/Dance Academy: See separate *Clothes List Shrewsbury*.

What NOT to bring

- Unnecessary valuables (expensive watches, jewellery etc.)
- Any clothes that are delicate and unsuitable for a school laundry

Visitors to the Centres

Any relative or friend who wants to take a student out during the course must have the permission of the Course Director. The parent/guardian of the student must sign a form before permission can be given.

Health

Students who have any allergies (e.g. bees, penicillin) or who need a special diet must inform us as soon as possible. If you are taking any medication, please bring a letter (in English) from your doctor with you. Each centre is registered with a local medical practice. Any student may be charged for a consultation with a doctor however in most cases initial consultation is free. Students from countries outside the EU are not entitled to free treatment but are insured under the Discovery Summer policy providing they do not need treatment for a pre-existing condition. The first £25 of each claim is not covered.

English Lessons (not Winchester)

You will be tested and graded on arrival and placed in a class at your level. The aim of our lessons is to help you improve your communication skills. It is very likely we shall be using materials and methods that you are not familiar with, so do not be surprised!

Problems / Complaints

If your child has any problem during the course, please tell him / her to talk immediately to a staff member who will try to help resolve it. If it is not resolved quickly, please encourage your child to speak to the Course Director who has overall responsibility for the course and is available 24 hours a day. DO

- Speak English
- Be on time (always)
- Be kind and friendly to other students
- Join in all the lessons and activities
- Look after your belongings and the school
- Keep your room tidy
- Stay in your bedroom after bedtime and remain quiet
- Give all your money to the Course Director / Administrator to look after
- Have your *Discovery ID* card with you at all times

DON'T

- Leave the campus unless with staff
- Smoke, drink alcohol or take drugs
- Chew gum
- Bring or buy knives, weapons or toy guns
- Swear or fight
- Drop litter
- Use your mobile phone, MP3 players or handheld games console in lessons, activities or meetings
- Damage school property
- Steal or shoplift
- Swim without a lifeguard being present
- Use fire escapes unless for emergency exit
- Go into boys' accommodation if you are a girl
- Go into girls' accommodation if you are a boy

PLEASE NOTE

- On arrival you will be asked to hand in your airline ticket, passport and all cash for safekeeping
- Pocket money can be taken out at stated times (usually before excursions)
- On arrival a £30 damage / key deposit will be taken from you. If no damage, loss or nuisance has been caused, this will be refunded on departure.
- All valuables must be locked away in your locker / safe / suitcase or handed to the Course Office for safekeeping. We cannot accept responsibility for items or money not handed in.
- Any students breaking British Law, or persisting in serious anti-social behaviour, will be disciplined. In serious cases, students may be sent home early at their own expense, with no refund of fees.
