

Information for non - residential English Student Hosts, 2020

Discovery Summer is a leading provider of residential summer courses for international children and teenagers who come to the UK to learn new skills, try new activities and enjoy new experiences - in English.

We welcome some 60 nationalities each summer.

We want the international students to enjoy getting to know our country and culture, to share their experience with new friends from around the world and to make British friends - our '**English Student Hosts**'.



Discovery Summer offers a limited number of all-inclusive full-day scholarships to British children and teenagers. These English Student Host make up 10% of our total student population.

What is included in the residential scholarship offer?

- A two-week **scholarship** in a safe, fun and culturally enriching environment at a top independent school
- Experience the full programme arriving in time for the morning student meeting (normally 08.45h) and stay until the afternoon, when activities finish (normally 18.00h). Lunch is provided.
- **Develop new skills** as you support international students
- Daily guidance from your House Parents ensuring you understand your role
- Two excursions a week e.g. **Warner Bros studio, a West End Musical and Theme Parks** as well as many places of historical and cultural interest e.g. Bristol, Oxford and London.
- A huge variety of indoor and outdoor sports and activities, art & design, circus skills, ceilidhs, dance, discos, sports, leadership challenges and more!

Day scholarships:

Queen's Gate

- Monday to Friday
- Arrival time: 08.45h, Departure time: 17.00

Marymount and Cobham (EMA/GYL)

- Monday to Friday
- Arrival time: 08.45, Departure time: 17.45 (There may be opportunities to stay for the evening activities)
- There may be opportunities to join the Sunday full day excursion (*subject to availability*)
- Students must be dropped off and picked up by a parent/guardian

Radley

- Scholarship places start on Wednesdays
- Student Hosts arrive at 08.45 and depart at 17.45
- Student Hosts may attend at the weekend

Applicants should be:

- British (and living or been educated in the UK)
- Aged between 11 and 17 years
- Available for 2 consecutive weeks in the summer
- Independent - spend time away from family and friends
- Confident - every day you will be meeting new people!
- Enthusiastic and inquisitive
- Responsible – you need to lead by example
- Mature – you may need to put the needs of the international students before your own
- Resilient – you may find something hard at first e.g. spending time with children you do not know
- Friendly, kind and polite

English Student Host duties:

- Welcome new international students to the centre, show them around and help them meet other students and to settle in
- Help students in classes - these may be English or subject-based classes depending on the programme
- Help students practise for spoken English exams
- Participate in a wide range of sports, activities and evening entertainments
- Go on two excursions each week; sharing British culture and local know-how
- Set an excellent example by always following Discovery Summer rules and by helping whenever you can
- Mix with the international students at every possible opportunity
- Wear a Discovery Summer blue T-shirt to be easily recognised

What you will gain from being an English Student Host

You may have just started a new school, or you might be applying to university. Our scholarship programme gives you confidence in new situations while teaching you important life skills:

- Gain **interview** experience. The application process includes a brief telephone interview
- Build on your **leadership skills** as you guide and support international students
- Improve your **social skills and confidence** when meeting new people
- Boost **resilience** as you realise what you have achieved
- Gain **new skills** – perhaps in an unexpected area – in classes, activities, sports, or in ways of helping people
- Discuss your **future plans** with experienced staff
- Find out how well you are fulfilling your role. This daily feedback can be used as a **basis of a reference** for a **Duke of Edinburgh Award** or to support an application for a part time job/gap year project/University etc
- **Enhance your CV** with proven leadership experience
- Receive a DS English Student Host certificate as a **record of your achievement**
