

Golf Academy – all levels

Our golf programme takes place at Shrewsbury Golf Club, Shropshire’s finest golf course, situated 6 miles south of Shrewsbury. It is led by a highly experienced PGA professional, John Richards, and his team of assistant professionals who also instruct on the covered driving range, the pitching/putting greens on the 18-hole golf course. All aspects of the game are covered and video analysis is used to help students improve their technique. Advanced players spend most of their time on the course whilst beginners spend half on the range and half on the course. Transportation included.

Thursday	Assessment of Level Practise the basics of all areas of golf including long game, chipping and putting
Friday	Aim: to continue improving techniques in all areas so that next session can take place on the course Practice chipping, putting and long game
Saturday	Mixed session with advanced players All players work on technique with the use of games. Groups are mixed so that beginners can learn from their peers Practice on the golf course
Monday	Students will play a round of golf accompanied by the professionals
Tuesday	Students complete a range of drills and tests to determine what level the students have reached. Bronze, silver and gold award certificates are presented at the end of the session

This programme also includes 15 hours’ English tuition on five afternoons each week.
